BRIEF PRESENTATION OF OUR GROUP

Climate Volunteers (CLIVO) is an informal group founded by a group of high school and university students in Antalya. We have different backgrounds, but we focus on the climate act and green entrepreneurship altogether. Our mission is to promote climate change awareness in our community, support young people for green entrepreneurship. We believe that the world can be better with our efforts and through sustainable actions.

Our group consists of 12 people who are mostly students, and a bio scientist, a few educators and a counselor. We are committed ourselves to a sustainable future and we want to improve the social, economic, and environmental well-being of our community through our Climate Acts. We are dedicated to environmental improvements that foster a sustainable future leading to social and economic improvements in our community. Our goal is to help protect the environment for generations to come. Our group is very new, so we want to meet young people from different parts of Europe and work on Youth Projects cooperatively.

CLIVO is highly motivated to take active roles in:

- guiding the youth to increase their environmental awareness in our local area;
- supporting active citizenship by developing the knowledge, attitude, skills, and actions of youngsters about climate change in our local area;
- engaging the youth in various activities such as gardening, safe biking, cooking, beach cleaning, 3 R's (Reduce-Recycle-Reuse) to spend their time effectively;
- organizing training/seminars at the Municipality Hall to raise the awareness of local young people about different issues such as environment, green entrepreneurship, sustainability lifestyles., etc.

OUR ACTIVITIES AND EXPERIENCE RELEVANT FOR THIS PROJECT

Our local area, Döşemealtı is about 25 km away from Antalya city center. The inhabitants are mostly farmers which makes the social and economic profile of local people quite low. Therefore, we prefer working with disadvantaged young people in our projects, events, and trainings.

Our Municipality opened a new Youth Center in 2019. This center welcomes the local children, teens, and the youth and gives those opportunities to fill their free time with sports, music, drama, and other social and cultural activities. Also, it has a conference hall, swimming pool, music room and library where CLIVO members do volunteer work.

Although it has not been long time since we formed our informal group, the group members have known each other for a long time and some of them have been very active in EU projects, youth work and volunteer work for several years. For example:

- Some participants in the group have implemented Erasmus+ KA1 & KA2 projects in the school education and youth field
- Our director has already mentored some young people doing EVS in Antalya;
- 1 of the youth leaders (Hüseyin Çağlar İnce <https://www.dogadabuan.com/>) has committed himself to educating people from 7-to 70 about nature, climate change, birdwatching, biodiversity;
- Our high school has Climate Change Education as an extracurricular activity
- We attend EU project development training, write projects, use international platforms, and grow our collaboration with the youth from other countries.

CLIVO is growing rapidly. We have already two youth projects (KA152 and KA153) approved in 2022. We are looking forward to collaborating other European young people to make our world greener and more sustainable.
